Policy: Member in Good Standing

A member club is a 'Member in Good Standing' of OSHA if they meet the following criteria:

- Paid their annual OSHA fee
- Completed and returned annual registration questionnaire form
- Attend the AGM and at least one of the two other scheduled general meetings
- Are running an active sledge program
- Comply with OSHA Insurance requirements
- Use certified coaches, trainers and on ice officials

A Member in Good Standing is also expected to live up to the following principles and values:

- Conduct the business of their club and teams in a manner consistent with the OSHA Constitution, the OSHA sledge hockey rules and any regulations and policies adopted by OSHA.
- Adhere to a code of ethics and behavior that reflects the ideals and goals of sledge hockey, respect for players and supporters and a sense of fair play.
- Support and promote the growth of sledge and OSHA in a positive manner with the media, at public events and with the general community at large.
